Entry Requirements

Entry into this course required successful completion of Australian Year 10 or equivalent, OR, relevant work experience in a related field.

Other requirements

Students must obtain a Working with Children Check (WWVC) prior to commencing work placement. In some cases, your work placement employers may also ask students to obtain a Australia Federal Police Clearance.
